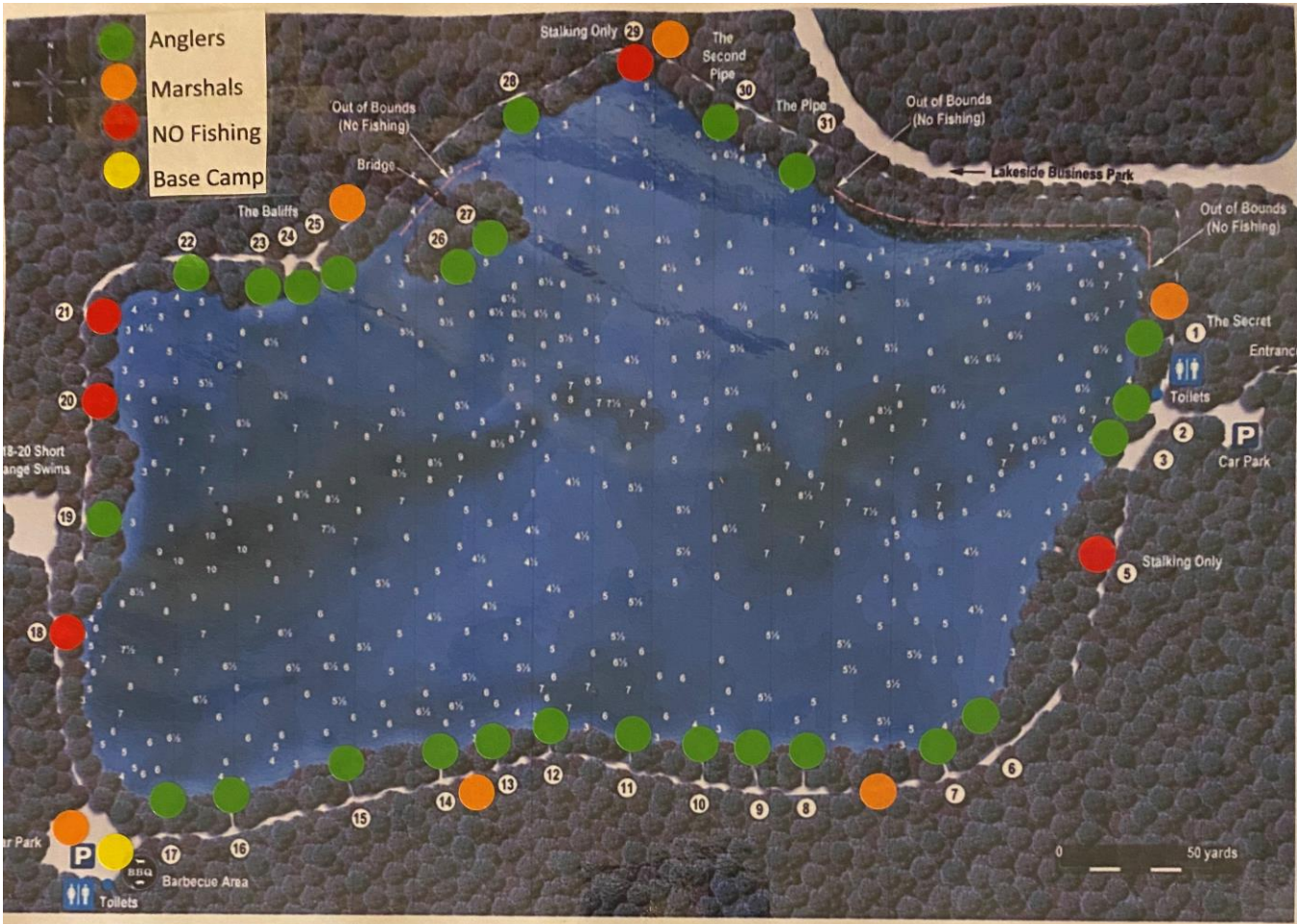
EVENT LOCATION

7. You are all fully aware of the difficulties that we face when organising a social event, the Phoenix Heroes policies are in line with Government Guidelines, and these must always be respected. We are restricted on numbers attending and therefore we are unable to allow guest at any point during the event. If we have unexpected guest arrive then we will have no alternative but to refuse them entry otherwise this will put the event in jeopardy and breach the venue owner's policy. Prior to attending you **MUST** complete the online acceptance form.

*To be clear, no guest is allowed at any point during the event.

FACILITIES

8. The facilities at Sandhurst Lake are excellent, we have everything that we need to make this a comfortable and enjoyable event.

Feeding – All feeding will be the responsibility of the angler to self-cater, there are several delivery takeaway menus available who will deliver direct to venue.

Toilets – There are onsite portaloos, please keep them clean and reel your rods in if you leave your swim.

Carpark – There are two carparks, first arrivals will park at the top carpark and when this is full the remainder will park in the main carpark at the entrance gate.

Local Amenities – If you need any resupplies then a few minutes' drive away you have access to the local shops.

Medical – Phoenix Heroes has a full medical kit onsite for minor injuries, in the event of a serious accident then 999 call is the protocol.

VALUES & STANDARDS

9. It goes without saying that our values and standards are high, everyone that is attending are representing Phoenix Heroes and we want to make a lasting impression on the venue owners for future bookings so please always act in an appropriate manner.

Alcohol – We do permit alcohol on venue, but this must be in moderation, anyone that we deem to have taken advantage of this will be asked to leave the venue.

Drugs – Under no circumstances are drugs of any type unless prescribed medication allowed on venue, failing to comply with this then you will be asked to leave the venue.

Litter – You will be issued with a bin bag to tidy up your own swims, all rubbish must be taken away with you as there are no facilities for bulk rubbish on venue.

Abusive Behaviour – Abusive behaviour to any support staff, participants or venue staff will not be tolerated, anyone not respecting this will be asked to leave venue.
